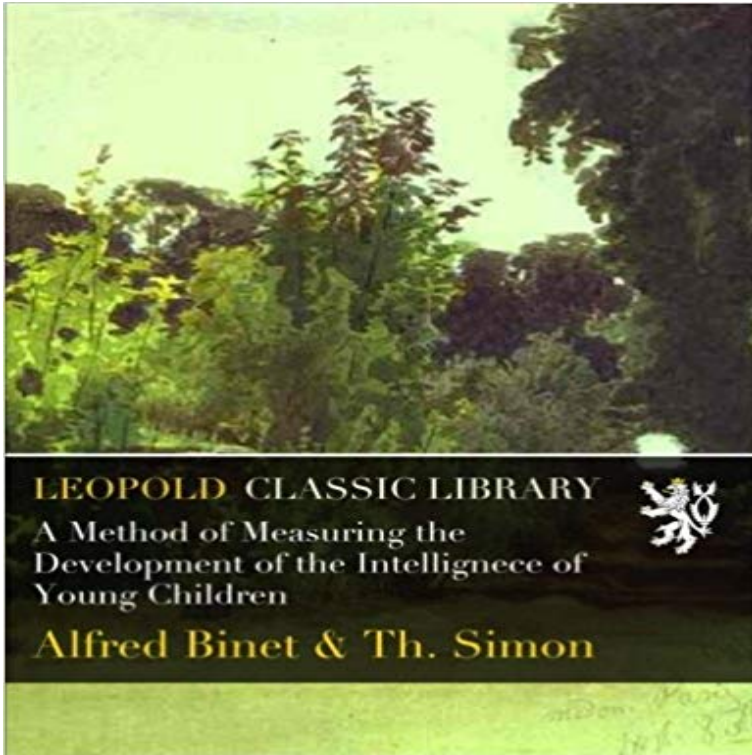


A Method of Measuring the Development of the Intelligence of Young Children
