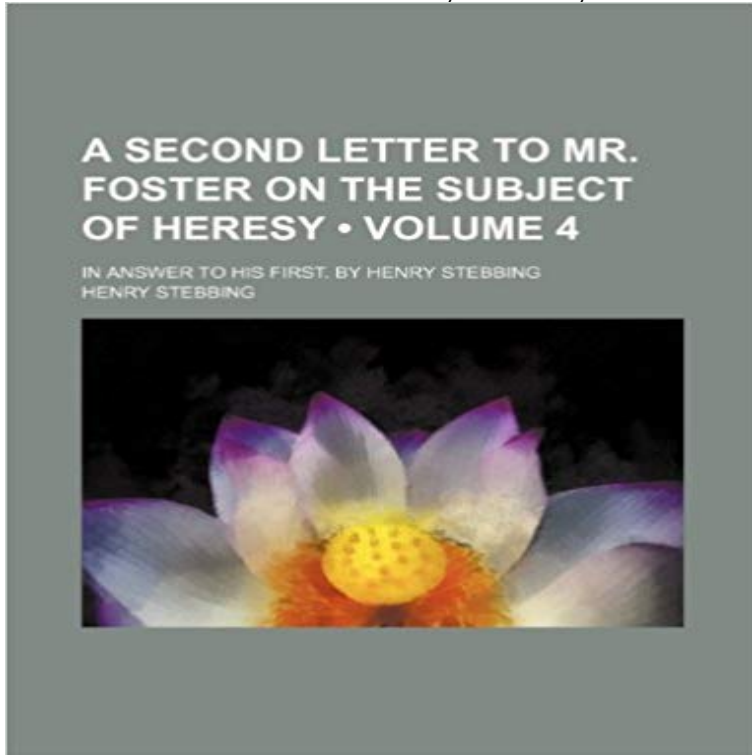

Perhaps, Sir, it might be observed of your Letter with great Justice, that, whilst you are condemning Arts and Amusements, you are perpetually fleeing to them, as your only Supports. But that I may not give you new Offence, let this appear or not appear
