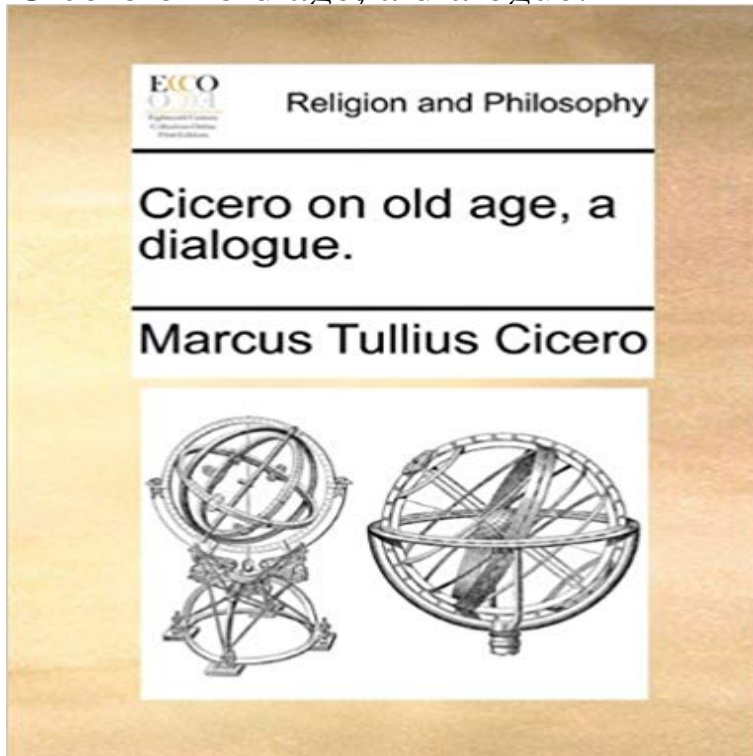


Cicero on old age, a dialogue.
