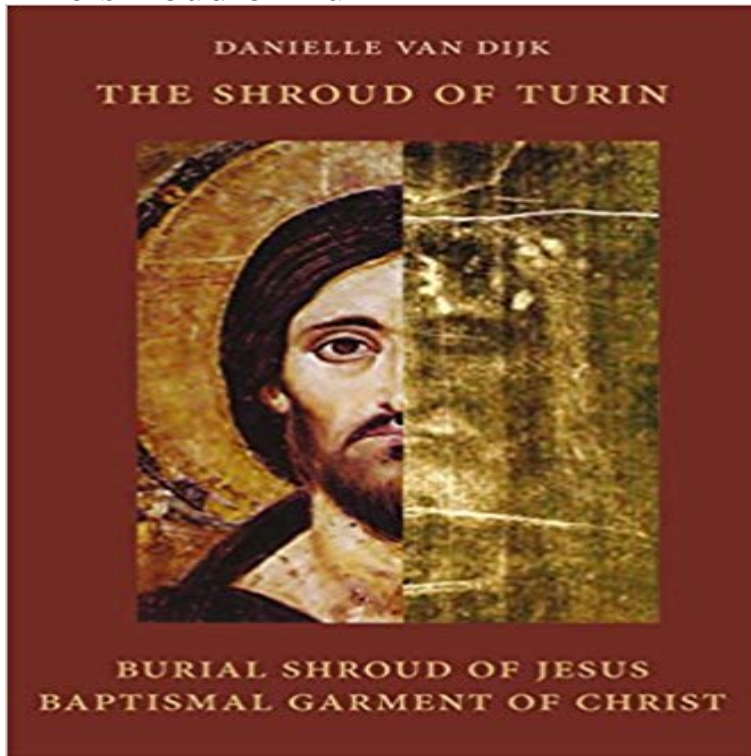


The shroud of Turin
